## Volunteer contributions.


Together we accomplish what none of us could do alone and volunteers give generously of their time. The most recent calculation of the value of a volunteer hour is \$31.80.

"Dear Dr. Jenkins,

As I sit at my computer writing this letter, I'm looking at a picture of George with our three grandsons. How different things would be right now if not for you. Our lives are all in the hand of the Creator but He uses people to bring about His perfect will.

When I met you for the first time, as you came out of the recovery area following George's surgery, I had no idea that George's survival from his heart attack hinged heavily on the program you put in place to assure his best outcome. But right away I knew you had a compassionate heart and that you were extremely skilled, and very honest and thorough as a doctor. I remember you telling me that George was out of surgery and

doing well. I was so very relieved, if not a bit shocked. When I watched Life Flight lift off, before I hopped in the car to drive to Kootenai, I wasn't sure if George would be alive when I arrived. My mind kept going to the picture of him in our home as I was giving him CPR – he was blue and foam was coming out of his mouth – it didn't look good.

We are both so very thankful for you! Thankful that you saw fit to improve the emergency response time in Bonner County. Thankful that you started the STEMI Program that brings so many components together to meet the needs of critical patients. Thankful for your God-given skill as an excellent cardiac doctor. And thankful that George is still here with us – with his heart functioning well.

Lastly, we are grateful to have been a small part of the commercial that highlights Kootenai Health's Level 1 STEMI Center, and the critical role you play as one of their cardiologists. I still recall the filming of the commercial at the hospital, after ten or so takes of you and George coming down the stairs, you commented, "I only get one chance to get it right." Shannon and I laughed so hard – but George and I are so very thankful you got it right!

George and I have made a gift to the heart center in recognition of you and all you have done for our family – thank you!"




