of the past two years have taught us anything, it is to be grateful for what is truly important – friends, family, and moments of connection. While the 2021 Festival of Trees will be a virtual event, we have all learned that we can still find ways to be together even when we are apart!

As we enter this season of giving, we want to take a moment to appreciate all our community has done for Kootenai Health and the Health Care Heroes who work here. Generous donors provided financial support. Hundreds of individuals – adults and children alike – wrote heart-felt cards and letters of encouragement. For the second year in a row, Rotarians delivered dozens upon dozens of roses to health care workers. We even had a group of art students from North Idaho College create a graffiti art message, "We ♥ Our Health Care Heroes," along Kootenai Health Way where it can be seen from the COVID-19 unit.

The acts of kindness are too numerous to list, but all are deeply appreciated and have been a beacon of hope throughout this dark pandemic.

Although COVID-19 may not be fully behind us, for our 33rd annual Festival of Trees, we are turning our attention to the future as we work to support the further development of Kootenai Health's growing neurosciences program. Today we are providing nonsurgical care for multiple sclerosis, neuromuscular disorders, movement disorders, epilepsy and seizures, stroke, and electrodiagnostic testing. Our neurosurgery program is providing brain surgery, spinal surgery and deep brain stimulation here in our community.

This year's Festival of Trees will help Kootenai Health purchase a StealthStation S8 Surgical Navigation system and KINEVO microscope. These state-of-the-art pieces of equipment will aid neurosurgeons as they perform exacting - and life changing – surgical procedures. With many patients now able to receive these procedures. which may have been delayed during COVID-19, our physicians and nurses are eager to begin using Surgical Navigation and the KINEVO microscope in the operating room!

Thank you for continuing to support your community hospital and best wishes as we enter 2022.


